DATES AND TIMES

Camp begins on Monday, June 22, and runs through Friday, July 17. Camp will be located at the Chabad center. 24729 Valley St. Newhall

Camp runs Monday thru Friday 9:00 am – 3:00 pm. For those signed up for aftercare, pickup is 4:00pm. Please be sure to drop off your children on time as on some days we will be leaving camp grounds right away. Be prompt in picking up your child(ren).

FEES

Full summer: \$1250 (Early Bird \$1,150)

1 Week session (5 days): \$350 (Early Bird \$320)

1 Week session (M,W,F): \$260

Lunch \$20 per week \$80 for the full summer

Tuition fees cover all activities and trips. One camp T- shirt will be given to every camper on the first day of camp. Additional T- shirts can be purchased for \$15 each.

Water days

On water days, if possible, please have your children wear their swimwear under their clothes and bring a towel in a tote or plastic bag. Please have all bathing suits and towels marked with permanent ink or labels.

On Monday and Wednesdays pickup will be from the Newhall Pool on Newhall Ave.

MEDICATION

All medication to be administered during camp hours must be clearly marked with camper's name. A separate note containing dosage instruction and parent's signature must be sent as well. Please discuss details with the counselor and director.

LUNCH AND SNACKS & Menu

We are offering optional hot lunches for \$20 per week. Every lunch includes a fruit/vegetable and drink. Campers who are not signed up for hot lunches should bring a dairy or pareve (no meat) lunch. On Wednesdays, we will be serving pizza lunch at no extra fee. On trip days, lunches should be brought in disposable bags and containers only. Morning snacks will be provided. This includes crackers, fruit, pretzels and juice. Water will be available to campers at all times.

GENERAL CAMP POLICY

Pick up and Drop off

Dropoff begins at 8:45. There will be a drive through for parents to pick up and drop off children. A counselor will be at the car to take your child in. If for any reason you need to come in, Please park your car on the street so it doesn't disturb the carpool lane.

End of the day pick up is at 3:00pm.

On Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, pickup will be from camp.

On Monday and Wednesdays pickup will be from the Newhall Pool on Newhall Ave.

SIGN IN/SIGN OUT

Every camper must be signed in and out daily.

CAMPER RELEASE

Parents wishing to have their child released during camp to anyone other than themselves or their designate must make prior arrangements with the Camp Director.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

1. Camp does not take the responsibility for any personal items brought to camp
2. Personal sports equipment such as bats, hockey sticks sports balls, etc. will be stored by the counselor and used under staff supervision.
3. ABSOLUTELY NO illegal substance or weapon of any kind will be allowed on campgrounds.
4. **Smart phones are not allowed in camp.** If you need to reach your child during camp hours, you could call one of the directors.

REQUENTLY ASKED Questions

1) Must campers wear a camp shirt every day?

No. We require that all campers wear a Camp Gan Israel T-shirt on Trip Days.

2) How does my camper find lost items?

Please mark all belongings with your camper's name and group. This is very important since shirts, water bottles, caps etc. are identical and individual items are difficult to identify without a label. Lost & Found items are available each day at pickup. Please contact us in writing or by phone regarding specific items.

3) How does the transportation system work?

Camp Gan Israel uses a modern fleet of School buses for trips. We transport the campers to the pool in vans. We are always looking for parent volunteers to help carpool to Newhall pool. It's under 1 mile from camp. Campers must remain seated at all times. Camp has booster seats. If you have a particular one you want us to use, you can leave it at dropoff and take it at pickup.

4) How do I arrange to pick up my camper during the camp day?

If you have to pick up your camper during the day, please notify our office. Once we are aware of your arrival time, we can arrange to have your camper ready for you. Please note that no camper will be released to ANYONE without parental permission.

5) What if my child does not want to participate in a particular activity?

No camper is required to participate in any activity. However, we do urge campers to try all activities and take advantage of the complete program offered at Camp Gan Israel.

6) Can my camper bring precious items to camp?

We do not permit your camper to bring jewelry, radios, expensive toys, smart phones etc. to camp. Camp Gan Israel supplies everything campers may need for the day..

7) What does my camper need to bring each day?

Campers will need to bring a lunch every day if they are not signed up for hot lunch, excluding Wednesday. They will need a bathing suit and towel on water days. We supply all sports and safety equipment. Counselors will apply sunscreen upon request.

8) How can I speak with a Camp Director?

The director is available to answer your questions, discuss your concerns, etc. most evenings from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. (except Fridays) at (661) 644-5734. Please feel free to call during these times or leave a message at the camp office during the camp day.
